2010-2011 Executive Positions

Two very important positions on our Executive are available for willing volunteers for the 2010-2011 season. All executive are required to attend meetings once per month. You must attend 80% of the meetings in order to be credited for your sweat equity. Both positions would require some background knowledge of Synchronized Skating. A job description and sweat equity (\$200 is required and remainder is deducted from your fees) for each is as listed below:

General Manager

- Sweat Equity: \$600.00
- Computer skills required - Microsoft office - Word, Excel and Access
- 10 - 20 hours per week during the skating season

Duties include: (some duties shared with Assistant Manager)

- Provide Leadership and oversee duties for the Club, Coaches, Skaters and Executive
- Skater Registration and Ice Scheduling
- Competition Registration and Scheduling
- CanSynchro Registration and Badge Tracking
- Book Ice with City of Regina
- Attend Skate Regina Meetings once per month
- Organize events, exhibition skates, AGM and banquet
- Oversee communication for all events
- Plan future programming needs
- Oversee Budgeting
- File year end corporate return
- Make sure all skaters have a sweat equity

Treasurer

- Sweat Equity: 900.00
- Computer Skills Required: Microsoft Excel
- 20 hours per week during skating season, some during off season

Duties include:

- Maintain budgets for the club and all skaters/teams
- Work with Team Accounts Managers to maintain skater account records
- Report GST and file
- File yearly Tax Return
- Distribute funds accordingly from Fundraising events

If you are interested in either of these positions please contact Susan at swaldal@accesscomm.ca or 586 7377. The positions need to be filled by February 15, 2010. This would allow training time prior to the current Manager's and Treasurer's deadline date of March 31, 2010. The current Manager and Treasurer will still be members of the club next season and will be available to assist you as you become familiar with your duties. There is a possibility that some of the duties of the Manager could be divided if there are more volunteers interested. Currently the Manager and Assistant Manager Co-Manage the club. If this case then the sweat equity would be adjusted accordingly.

Should there be no volunteers come forward, the Membership will be presented with an option, at the AGM on February 21, to hire an administrator for the next season. This would result in an increase in fees for everyone.
